

ATSC 1.0 HOST EXHIBIT

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3801(i)(4), Educational Broadcasting Foundation, Inc, licensee of WLAE-TV, New Orleans, LA (Facility ID No. 18819) (“WLAE-TV”), hereby provides the following information in support of its request to license guest ATSC 1.0 multicast streams in connection with the operation of WLAE-TV as a Next Gen TV broadcast facility:

The above-referenced programming streams are the same number of programming streams, and in the same resolutions as, or lower than, the programming streams that WLAE-TV has been broadcasting on its own ATSC 1.0 facility prior to transitioning to ATSC 3.0. Accordingly, WLAE-TV is not seeking to license more capacity on the Host Station, in the aggregate, than WLAE-TV would use if it were still operating its own facility in ATSC 1.0. Contour maps of WLAE-TV and the ATSC 1.0 Host Station showing the noise-limited coverage and predicted population served by WLAE-TV’s original ATSC 1.0 signal that are also served by the Host Station are included in Engineering Statement.

WLAE-TV currently schedules at least three-hours per week of core programming on its

primary stream, and therefore does not currently, and does not intend to, rely on its non-primary multicast streams for compliance with the Commission's children's television programming requirements. Accordingly, WLAE-TV's compliance with the Commission's children's television programming requirements and viewers' access to the station's core programming is not affected by the broadcast of its multicast streams from the ATSC 1.0 Host Station. In any event, as noted above, WLAE-TV's multicast streams are carried on the ATSC 1.0 Host Station, which serves more than 100 percent of the predicted population served by WLAE-TV's original ATSC 1.0 signal.

WLAE-TV has provided the required notifications to viewers and the relevant MVPD distributors.
